1- INTRODUCTION OF BOARD & SOME ITS BRANCHES

Board of Intermediate & Secondary Education, Faisalabad was established in 1988. Building of Board of Intermediate & Secondary Education is on the main Jhang Road near Faisalabad International Airport. Total area owned by BISE, Faisalabad is 212k, 12m, 2s. Districts of Faisalabad, T.T.Singh, Chiniot, and Jhang comes under its jurisdiction. Board of Intermediate & Secondary Education Faisalabad is rendering services for the quality Education by providing equal opportunity for all candidates in examination, comfortable environment with online registration, migration and admission facility. Every year beside academic activities Board conduct co-curricular activities like Adbi-Muqablat, Painting, Scientific exhibition and Sports activities at district and division level. The Board generates its own funds through registration, examinations and admission fee, it does not receive any donation or gift from any entity whether Govt. or Private.

1- Academic branch

Education Board is the examination conducting body. Being the senior most and well educated officer I have served in various posts in this office under patronship of a beautiful galaxy of Chairpersons BISE Fsd especially the present chairperson. Perfection is not possible but at the same time nothing remains impossible for a willing mind and warm devotion. During my service I really impressed by some officers specially Ch. Riaz Ahmad Chairman, Syed Mumtaz Hussain Shah Chairman, Dr. Shoukat Ali Shoukat Secretary, Dr. Syed Riaz Hussain Shah Secretary, Prof. Hamid Khalil Secretary.

The academic branch performs functions that are directly and indirectly of public significance and interest as mentioned below:

Affiliation of Institutions: The application of private institutions and extension in affiliations is being granted in accordance with the rules and regulations provided in Board's Calendar Act 1976 to maintain the quality education. The Board administration is strictly following Govt. rules and regulations in order to assess and examine schools for affiliation and extension. The extension/affiliation on merit as per Govt. SOP's mentioned time to time. This has resulted in the amelioration of education and the facilities rendered by the schools. Many schools that don't even have the basic foundations to be called as High or Higher secondary schools, i.e: proper building, classroom according to the student's capacity, equipped laboratory, playground, well maintained and update acquittance roll as per Govt. SOP's and hygienic conditions.

In order to remove the deficiencies board administration have taken private schools and their association on board to assure quality education and healthy environment.

Correction Cases: The application for correction of name, father's name and date of birth are received in general branch. At submission of application letter for provision of record is issued at same time to the applicants. Text message service in this regard is going to be activated. So the enquiries are dealt through online system on the very same day.

One Window: NOC, Verification of documents, migration certificate and duplicate result card etc. is being issued on one window section of General branch on the same day. The cumbersome and lengthy process has been reduced to matter of few hours.

2- Administration branch

Admin branch is headed by Mr. Muhammad Saeed Awan, Deputy Secretary (Admin) and work under supervision of Secretary Board. Admin branch is the back bone of the board because of the functions it performs.

Some of its main duties are as follows:

- 1) It is responsible for transfer, posting of officers/officials within board when and where required.
- 2) Initiates disciplinary action against board employees.
- 3) Deals promotion/service matters of the board employees.
- 4) Maintains record/personal files of the board employees.
- 5) Deals legal matters of the board in Subordinate and Higher judiciary through legal consultants.
- 6) Deals with the pay and pensioner matters.
- 7) Facilitates board employees for medical treatment from different hospitals
- 8) Arranges meetings of BOG and other board committees.
- 9) Provides information to controlling authority as and when required.

2- BOARD NEWS

colleges of Fsd division. The Chief Guest of the ceremony was Ch. Raza Nasrullah Ghuman (MNA). The Naat competition started with the recitation of Holy Quran. District level winners of Chinioot, Jhang, Toba Tek Singh and Faisalabad division participated in competition of divisional level at school and college level.

A quiz competition was held at Secondary and Higher Secondary level. This comprise Two stages.

i- Written (100 marks MCQ's written paper on Makki, Madni life of Hazrat Muhammad ﷺ and Quran Pak).

ii- Oral Quiz.

30 students each from school and college level selected for oral quiz on the basis of marks in written paper. School level Naat Competition was won by Sana Fatima of Govt. G H/S Jhang and College level Naat competition was won by Faiz Amin of KIMS College Chinioot. Similarly Islamic quiz was won at school side by Muhammad Saeed Amjad of Govt. The Chief Guest Raza Nasrullah Ghuman along with Chairperson, Secretary and Contoller Fsd Board distributed cash prizes and certificates among the winner of the competition.

(iii) Literary Competition

Art and literature of any nation is reflection of its traditional colors, cultural diversity, beauty, strength of language and encyclopedia of their history. History of Pakistan is incomplete without its founding father Quaid-e-Azam Muhammad Ali Jinnah and Allama Muhammad Iqbal. same institute won the competition. Quaid day was also celebrated by holding a speech competition on vision and thought of Quaid-e-Azam Muhammad Ali Jinnah. Topic of Secondary School was "قائد اعظم کا پاکستان" and for Higher Secondary School was "قائد اعظم اور مورسلطنت". 63 students of school and 43 of college participated in the competition. Bilal abid, of Kips college jail road, Faisalabad won the speech competition on college side while, Syed Samiq Abbas bukhari, Divisional Model College, Faisalabad on school.

In the book competition, there were two categories:- I- Science/Research/Criticism II- Art and Literature.

Winner book in the first category as decided by the jury was 'Gojri Zuban o adab' by Dr Muhammad Ayub, Govt. PG College Samanabad, Faisalabad.
